The course focuses on hostile anti-piracy duties in the Gulf of Aden but the knowledge you acquire will prepare you for the global piracy problem.

At the end of the course you will have the skills to embark on maritime security duties which will include the mentoring and training of ship personnel in the protection of vessels.

### Who Should Attend?

Professional close protection officers with an experience of operating in hostile environments. Ideally candidates should have military experience. Maritime military experience is a benefit but not essential, as maritime protocol is covered on the course.
